Pray that many will respond so that we don't lose touch with them at the beginning of their careers when they will need our support and encouragement more than ever.

THURSDAY 23 APRIL

CMF is very grateful to qualified doctors, nurses and midwives who act as Medical/Nursing School Links. They support their local CMF student groups with hospitality, pastoral care and spiritual guidance. Pray for them as many have to fit this in with their own busy work schedules.

FRIDAY 24 APRIL

CMF offers a range of training opportunities to students interested in developing their speaking, debating, writing or evangelistic skills. Also, the **Global Track** helps prepare students who are considering healthcare work abroad. Pray for those who lead these 'tracks' and for participants to be equipped for the roles they feel God is calling them to.

SATURDAY 25 APRIL

A joint CMF and ICMDA student and junior doctors' conference will be taking place in Ireland from 31 October - 1 November, Please pray for wisdom for the planning team as they organise it and for more students and juniors from Ireland to come along and get involved in CMF groups.



SUNDAY 26 APRIL

Give thanks to God for the millions of lives saved around the world through simple vaccinations against measles, rubella, typhoid, smallpox and many other infectious diseases. Pray for all those involved in immunisation campaigns around the globe.

MONDAY 27 APRIL

Pray for the scientific community who seek to develop appropriate vaccines for diseases that threaten billions around the world, especially for those working on a COVID-19 vaccine.

TUESDAY 28 APRIL

Pray for all those involved in delivering vaccines to communities around the world. Pray especially for those working on innovative ways to get vaccinations to the most isolated, marginalised and vulnerable populations.

WEDNESDAY 29 APRIL

Pray for the World Health Organization as it seeks to work internationally to tackle vaccine hesitancy; that Ministries of Health would adopt the guidelines and roll these out throughout communities in every nation.

THURSDAY 30 APRIL

Stress Awareness Month. Stress is a condition for which there is no vaccine. Pray for someone you know who is either off sick currently due to stress, or those you know who are struggling with the pressures on them

FRIDAY 1 MAY

Pray for all those working to tackle global health inequalities; such as access to immunisations and basic primary healthcare, or to essential ante and post-natal care. Ask that God would grant them hope and courage to serve and speak up for the poor and marginalised.

SATURDAY 2 MAY

Pray today for school nurses, especially ones we may know, who have contact with many children; that God would enable them to serve the children and the schools well. In particular, help them to allay the fears and misconceptions many parents and children have about immunisation.



SUNDAY 3 MAY

Pray for student midwives in CMF groups and CUs across the country. Pray that they will live in such a way that their friends and coursemates will see in them something of Jesus' love. Pray that they will be bold in speaking about Jesus Christ and sharing his Good News.

MONDAY 4 MAY

Pray for midwives as they care for mothers who are struggling with mental illness during and after pregnancy. Pray that they will care with compassion and gentleness, as they walk through dark and confusing times.

TUESDAY 5 MAY

Pray for midwives working in public health as they seek to improve NHS services, especially to advance care for single mothers, teenage mothers and asylum seekers. May they seek to glorify God as they use the positions they have to demonstrate his love for those often on the fringes of society.

Pray for midwives working in areas with overstretched resources and low morale; that they may find refreshment in Jesus, our living water.

THURSDAY 7 MAY

Pray for midwives as they journey with mothers through difficult times of grief. Pray that they can share something of the hope we have of a time where there will be no more pain or suffering, as well as of the Spirit as our comforter and counsellor here and now.

FRIDAY 8 MAY

Pray for midwives working in overseas mission settings. Pray that they will know afresh that salvation is by grace alone so that when things are going well, they can be protected from pride. When they feel things are going badly that they might not be discouraged in their service. Pray especially for those who are working in areas where believers face persecution.

SATURDAY 9 MAY

Pray for newly qualified midwives in this time of transition. Pray that those who have moved to a new place would soon settle into their new environment, new church family and new job. Pray for them as they build relationships with colleagues and adjust to the demands and challenges of this next career stage.



SUNDAY 10 MAY

This week the world celebrates the 200th anniversary of the birth of Florence Nightingale, the founder of modern nursing. In designating 2020 as the International Year of the Nurse and the Midwife, the World Health Organisation has recognised the vital role of nursing and midwifery in global health. Give thanks today for the generations of godly women and men who have followed Florence's example into the caring professions, and the impact they continue to have in the world.

MONDAY 11 MAY

Pray for CMF to be effective in raising the profile of its nursing and midwifery ministry. Pray for nurses and midwives who don't yet know about CMF. Pray that God would make it known that there is a fellowship longing to welcome, unite and equip them.

Young adult carers aged between 16 and 18 years are twice as likely not to be in education, employment, or training (NEET) as the general population, and nearly half report having mental health problems.

Pray for support in school or work, and hope for these individuals.

THURSDAY 11 JUNE

One in four carers is a mental health carer. Behavioural problems associated with psychiatric disorders increase stress levels of carers and other family members. Pray that marriages would stay together and united in the middle of this, for clear communication between family members, and for investment in CAMHS and other mental health services to cope with the considerable demand for swifter and fuller support.

FRIDAY 12 JUNE

Pray for Christians caring for family members, friends or neighbours. Pray that the spiritual, as well as social and professional support that they need would be forthcoming, helping them to remain in fellowship with Christ and fellow believers.

SATURDAY 13 JUNE

CMF AGM. Today, about 40-60 CMF members from around the UK will gather in London to hear reports, pray, and discuss the future direction and ministry of CMF. Please lift to the Lord all those gathering today, and pray that his Holy Spirit and the Scriptures would guide and give wisdom to all who are present.

FRIDAY 31 JULY


