
How to get to the venue from the AIRPORT Madrid Barajas (Terminal T1, T2, T3 & T4)

To Amistad Cristiana Church (Friday & Saturday, Metro: Canal) by Metro

- 1. Take the Metro Line 8 at the station *Aeropuerto T4* or *T1/T2/T3* to **Nuevos Ministerios.**
- At Nuevos Ministerios change to Line 10 (Direction Puerta del Sur), Get off in Gregorio Marañon.
- 3. At Gregorio Marañon change to Line 7 (Direction Pitis). Get off in Canal. Estimated travel time: 35 min (8-10 stations).

To "On the red box" (Saturday & Sunday, Metro: Sol) by Metro

1. If you are at Canal, take Line 2 to Sol, It takes 15 minutes.
