## Why bother?!

We should speak up and do justice because we serve a God of justice! And He mandates us to promote social justice through our words and actions: 'Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy' (Proverbs 31:8-9).

The Bible overflows with evidence of God's social conscience. Jesus showed special concern for vulnerable people, eating with 'sinners' and saying, 'It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick' (Matthew 9:9-13). The Parable of the Sheep and Goats reminds us that God regards ignoring the plight of the world's poor, sick and imprisoned as akin to shunning Him (Matthew 25:31-46). And King David sang of the value God places on that most vulnerable patient group of all, the unborn (Psalm 139:13).

## Should I attend?

Medical schools are usually light on teaching the skills required to speak up for vulnerable patient groups. And career opportunities in medical politics are discussed but rarely. So this summer school has been designed to fill that gap! We're

looking for student and junior Christian healthcare professionals (HCPs) who want to learn more about social action and public policy work. Senior HCPs and non-HCPs are welcome too. So, if this is you then yes, you should attend!

## Who will teach me?

In an exciting collaboration with the [Christian Medical Fellowship](#) (CMF), our confirmed speakers include CMF staff members Drs John Greenall & Alex Bunn and our own Dr Rachael Pickering. We are all friendly and have real expertise in social action & public policy work.
