BUWASUNGUYI CLINIC was opened in rented premises in 1999. It moved to a purpose built clinic in Sisongofa village in 2005. As a model to take Christ centered health care to rural areas, it concentrates on mother and child care. Originally in Mbale district, it is now in Manafwa district.

J.O.Y HOSPICE is a private not-for-profit health care facility in Mbale town. It started in 2001 and offers general outpatient and inpatient services as well as specializing in holistic palliative care. A laboratory was added in 2004 and a medical store and administration office in 2008.
