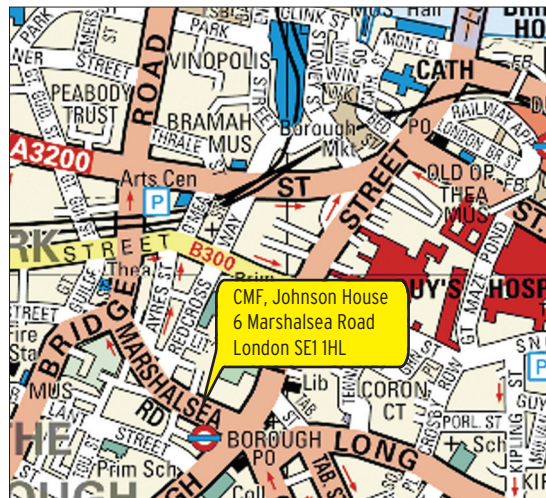

The closest underground stations are Borough (only 2 mins walk) and London Bridge (about 7-10 mins walk). From London Bridge Station, walk down Borough High Street until you reach the junction with Marshalsea Road and Great Dover Street. Borough tube station is directly opposite and St George the Martyr is on your left. If you go to your right you will find CMF, 50 metres down Marshalsea Road on your right.
