# Developing Health Course 2–14 July 2017

The Developing Health Course has been running for over 50 years, equipping doctors, nurses, midwives and allied health professionals for work in resource-poor settings. It covers a wide range of topics and includes practical workshops as well as lectures and case-based learning. Alongside the medical training, there is daily Bible teaching, prayer and reflection.

The course is designed for people:

- interested in international work or exploring work in resource-poor settings
- working internationally who want to update their knowledge
- preparing for international work who wish to be further equipped

The course runs for two weeks, during which most participants are residents at London School of Theology in North West London. However, it is possible to stay for one week only, or to attend individual special interest days.
