**T**his course is designed to update, equip and inspire people who are committed to global health, whether you are preparing to go outside of the UK to work, returning for a short break and want to update your learning, or considering whether getting involved in global health work is for you.

The course materials have been revised and now emphasise the broader context of health care across the world; strengthening healthcare systems, specific healthcare interventions as part of an integrated and multi-disciplinary setting, and learning to lead, learn and teach in such settings.

The course is taught by a broad range of highly experienced and skilled professional doctors, nurses and midwives who have all worked in global health and mission.

The two-week course will be held at London School of Theology (easily accessible from Heathrow and central London). Most course participants are resident for the duration of the course, although it is possible to book for a single week or to attend special interest days.
