

General facts

- One of the world's largest islands
- Located north of Australia
- Home to 9.9 million people
- The most linguistically diverse country with about 850 language groups
- 300 language groups with no Bible translation
- Melanesian culture is friendly, welcoming and community-orientated
- Tribal fighthing and problems with law and order in parts of the country

Medical facts

- One doctor for approx. 17,000 patients
- Doctors primarily in urban areas
- Major medical issues include infectious diseases (malaria, TB and HIV)
- Difficult to access maternity services, trauma care, child healthcare and non-communicable disease treatment

Your work

- Raise support/funding to come
- This is daunting but possible!
- Apply at least 9 months before you come for medical or nursing registration
- Be willing to learn the language and culture in order to communicate well with patients
- Commitment for 1+ years
- Depend on the Lord, be humble and willing to learn from others
- Be flexible and patient

- May offer guidance to help you raise support/funding
- May offer a pre-field orientation
- Provide training and valuable practical support during a placement
- Some have the capacity for medical elective students at different points of the year
