We live in a culture that constantly tells us to be true to ourselves but how do we actually know who that is? Is our identity based on more than just our feelings? And, how could knowing who we truly are change our lives? Does God have a plan for each one of us and, if so, how do we discover what that is?

Over this weekend, Paul Coulter will help us grapple with these questions as we explore what God teaches us in the letter to the Ephesians about our identity and purpose.

Dr Paul Coulter is Head of Ministry Operations at Living Leadership, a ministry which trains and supports church leaders to make disciples of Jesus. He is also Executive Director of the Centre for Christianity in Society which exists to connect Christ with contemporary culture.

Paul began his working life as a doctor based in Northern Ireland and continues to have a strong interest in bioethics. Since leaving medicine he has worked as a pastor, theologian and lecturer. He lives in Lisburn, is married to Gar-Ling, a geriatrician, and has two children.
