Hello! We are Integritas Healthcare Community Interest Company, a Christian medical social enterprise based in North Yorkshire. As a not-for-profit company, we are able to be motivated by our Judaeo-Christian ethical values rather than financial gain. We provide clinical services to prisoners and other vulnerable patients, both in the UK and in Resource-Poor Countries. Our educational arm, Petros Training, provides training (including SSCs) about medical ethics, deprivation medicine, social justice and medical politics. And we use our UK clinical income to fund our training and overseas activities. Our raison d'être is captured by Matthew 25:36, 'I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me'.

Where? This project is based on the beautiful western coast of the Philippine island of Luzon.

Who? Lead by experienced UK prison GPs, our teams work in partnership with Philippine Outreach Centre
Ministries (POCM), which provides non-medical prison and childcare services. We're looking for volunteers who are sympathetic to the

Medical training: provide emergency medical and

safeguarding training for POCM's staff

Offender healthcare: run medical clinics for prisoners

Paediatrics: do child health surveillance on POCM's

looked-after children

Play therapy: play with POCM's looked-after children

We do not charge for participation and teaching but we do ask that, especially if you are an elective student, you consider donating towards our drugs budget.
