Application process

- 1. **Meet with** local team leader to discuss. We want to match you to a role that suits you.
- 2. **Complete** the <u>Registration form</u> and return it to <u>volunteer@cmf.org.uk</u> copying in your team leader
- 3. **Outline** your role priorities setting simple goals with your Team Leader setting early expectations about time commitments and requirements is essential.
- 4. **Contact** the relevant facilitator for your role will be in touch to link you with others
- 5. Meet with the team locally and enjoy getting to know others!
- 6. Watch our training videos and peruse the members booklet!
