- ✓ Current roles: Prayer, Pastoral Care, Students, Juniors, Evangelism, Small Groups, Workplace Groups, Ethics, Nurses & Midwives, Logistics, Global.

### Application process

1. **Meet with** local team leader to discuss. We want to match you to a role that suits you.
2. **Complete** the [Registration form](#) and return it to [volunteer@cmf.org.uk](mailto:volunteer@cmf.org.uk) copying in your team leader
3. **Outline** your role priorities setting simple goals with your Team Leader – setting early expectations about time commitments and requirements is essential.
4. **Contact** - the relevant facilitator for your role will be in touch to link you with others
5. **Meet with** the team locally and enjoy getting to know others!
